It's building time again! Join us on Saturday, February 16, 2013 from 9 to 11:30 AM for the annual Block Kids Building Contest at the West Family YMCA. This popular program, which is co-sponsored by the Quad Cities Chapter 50 National Association of Women in Construction and the West Family YMCA, encourages participants to look for creative solutions to construction challenges.

Participants will receive 100 plastic building blocks, a piece of string, and a piece of aluminum foil to create a building project in 45 minutes.

The entrants will be judged by members of the Quad Cities building community. The project chosen by the judges as the most noteworthy will be entered in a regional contest. Winners at the regional level will then be entered in a national contest.




